Purpose

ZP Disposal Systems, LLC should strive to operate the best disposal facilities in the area. It should be the team's goal to place and maintain ZP Disposals Systems, LLC on the cutting edge of the oilfield service industry in all areas of influence through cooperation, dedication, new ideals, and improved methods. This will enable the company to minimize work load and maximize return on all assets. This position is a true contributor to the growth of our company through the investment and growth of our people, understanding that investing in people ultimately benefits us all. We should never forget that our greatest assets are the grace of God and our people.

Organizational Relationships

This position reports primarily to the ZP Disposal Maintenance Supervisor. Frequent contact with assigned work group, customer representatives, yard managers, and other service company representatives is required.

Essential Functions - Level 1 Disposal Technician

This is a self-motivated position that will require planning and coordination to achieve the goals of ZP Disposals Systems, LLC. The following list are some of the essential functions of the position, but the job is not limited to only the following.

- Keeping all equipment clean and serviceable.
- Power washing disposal sites, which includes tanks, pumps, pads, equipment, etc.

- Keeping locations free of trash and debris.
- Mowing/weed eating/spraying locations for bugs and weeds.
- Painting
- Inspection and replacing of basic parts on location.
- Maintain company vehicle/tools to a high standard of cleanliness.
- Operate tractor with attachments. (Box blade, Brush Hog, Bucket, etc)
- Submitting all invoices, paperwork, and forms in a timely fashion for approval or review.
- Basic understanding of how disposals work, layouts of disposals, and how to troubleshoot basic fluid manipulation to provide excellent service to our customers.

Essential Functions - Level 2 Disposal Technician

The essential functions for level 2 include level 1 functions in addition to level 2, but is not limited to the following:

- Troubleshooting all equipment and fixing all deficiencies.
- Maintenance/repairs of plunger pumps, centrifugal pumps, Murphy and Taylor switches, and minor electrical issues.
- Welding/fabrication
- Use of torch for heating and cutting purposes.
- Ability to communicate and facilitate projects and or solve basic disposal issues in absence of Maintenance Supervisor.

Work Schedule

This job is an hourly position that will require flexibility in hours and days worked because of the potential of breakdowns or unexpected assignments due to the unpredictability of the oilfield and its industry. The normal hours and days for the position will be five days a week beginning at 7:00 AM (with a 1-hour break for lunch) after training period is complete, with one week a month on-call. If it is your scheduled week to be on-call, you are to be available at 7:00 AM on the Tuesday which you are scheduled, and your week will conclude the following Tuesday at 7:00 AM. Remember this is the oilfield and that our schedule is not set in stone. Flexibility will be required to satisfy the company's needs and the needs of our customers.

Job Qualifications

- Must be focused and attentive to detail.
- Must have good troubleshooting/problem solving skills
- Must be able to operate or able to learn to operate power tools. (Drill, saw, etc.)
- Must be willing and able to learn machinery (Tractor, Power Washer, Sky Lift).
- Must be able to learn all maintenance procedures.
- Must be safety orientated.
- Must be drug and alcohol free.
- Must be able to be reliable and punctual.
- Welder/fabricator is preferred but can/will be taught to the right individual.
- Excellent attitude no matter the circumstances.
- Passion for your work.
- Pride for the job at hand.
- Excellent communication skills (phone, email, and person to person)
- Self-directed and motivated, but a team player with orientation to detail
- Flexible and having the ability to create and adapt to change.
- Ability and willingness to travel on work assignments; willingness to work additional hours during the work week and/or days off, if required.
- Places primary importance on delivering superior customer service.
- Possesses excellent multi-tasking skills. Prioritizes and performs a variety of concurrent tasks with minimal direction.
